Entry Details:

- Must be 21 to enter.
- Entries must be brought day of event between 4pm-6pm and dropped off for competition
- Only non-commercially brewed beer.
- Two (2)—12oz bottles, brown or green glass, de-labeled per entry. No flip top bottles, corked bottles, or wine bottles.
- If you are one of the Homebrew area participants, bottles and capping can be provided the day of the event to bottle the beer you bring to serve
- Complete entry form entirely. For more than one entry please make copies of entry form.
- Fold and rubber band entry form to each bottle. Rubber band the (2) bottles together.
- Homebrews will be judged based on Aroma, Appearance, Flavor, Mouthfeel, and Overall Impression.
- Entries can be disqualified for entry requirement infractions at Supercity Homebrew discretion.

Submission Categories:

- Yellow Beers: Styles of beer that would fall in this
 category include blonde ales, cream ales, wheat beers,
 Hefeweizen, light lagers, Kolsch, etc. Basically, if it is a
 lighter colored beer, and isn't hopped to IPA levels, it
 would go here.
- IPA's: Styles of beer that would fall in this category include English Pale Ales, India Pale Ales, American Pale Ales, New England IPA, etc. If hops are the focal point of the brew, it goes here.
- Amber/Brown, and Dark Beers: Styles of beer
 that would fall in this category include Amber ale, brown
 ale, amber lager, Munich Dunkel, Irish red ales, stouts,
 porters. If the beer is amber, copper, reddish, or dark in
 color it goes here.
- Other: Any beer that wouldn't fall into the above categories, mix of styles, or something completely off the wall goes here.

*Note — Beer categories may be further combined depending on number of entries.

Awards:

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place awards will be given for each Category
- Awards will be announced on the stage at the Supercity Brewfest @ 9:00pm. Highly encouraged to be present for photo op, but presence for awards "ceremony" is not mandatory.
